

## Silica Awareness in Construction and Respiratory Protection Course

OSHA began enforcement of 1926.1153 on September 23, 2017 to protect workers exposed to respirable crystalline silica in Construction. The new rule includes a new exposure limit for respirable crystalline silica and details widely used methods for controlling worker exposure, conducting medical surveillance, training workers about silica-related hazards and recordkeeping measures.

Under OSHA regulation 29 CFR 1910.134, employers are required to provide effective respirator training to those workers who are required to wear respirators, including some paper masks. The training must be comprehensive, understandable, and recur annually or more often, if necessary.

This training can serve as the bulk of classroom training as part of a respiratory training program; however, more training is required on the specific respirators that workers will use, and specific administrative and operational considerations in accordance with the employer's respiratory protection program.

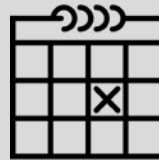
